PRODUCT DOCUMENTATION NOTICE

This memo describes changes made to the **enter x25p port**, **change x25p port**, and the **verify x25p port** commands.

For calls originated by an X.25P endpoint, if the calling address of the incoming call packet sent to the origination endpoint does not match the EPN of the origination endpoint, the calling address in the call packet is replaced by the lowest numbered EPN for that endpoint. A new prompt has been added to the **enter x25p port** and **change x25p port** commands that would turn off this substitution feature. The new prompt appears as follows:

CALLING ADDRESS SUBSTITUTION: [on, off +(on)]:

This prompt is displayed before the **LOCAL X.3 PROFILE ID** prompt.

If the "off" option is selected, the address in the incoming call packet will not be replaced, even if it does not match the address of the originating endpoint. If the "on" option is selected, the calling address will be replaced, as was always done before the addition of this feature.

The output of the **verify x25p port ...** command was modified to provide a field called **CALLING ADDR SUBSTITUTION**. The values for this field can be either "off" or "on".
